It is great to have the support of family involvement in their learning and really promotes great discussions at home.

During term 3, the Summer term, we're exploring 'Me and Relationships and Changing Me' in our Jigsaw topic, thinking about ourselves and how we can help each other in school.

We will be investigating 'The History of the Seaside' as part of our history topic. We will be looking at the past, what chronology is and using a wide vocabulary of everyday historical terms.

In art the children will be learning about 3D form. We will be look at sculptures with simple shapes, surfaces and lines. Alongside all this exciting new learning, our science work will be about light, shadows and reflection. We have some exciting investigations planned. We will also be learning about the importance of sun safety.

In R.E. our YR3's will be learning out the 'Kingdom of God' and our YR2's will be looking at Humanism. Our PE day is Thursday, so if you could please ensure that your child's PE kit is in school that day. In PE we are exploring striking and fielding, allowing children to try new games and working together.
