<b>Art &amp; Design and Technology</b> - During this first term we will be looking at 3D form including drawing and modelling. During the second term, we will be looking food and nutrition for our Design and Technology part of the curriculum.	<b>English</b> - Children will receive daily phonics teaching and at the end of each week information and tasks will be emailed out. In addition, children will be involved in shared, guided & individual reading. Children will learn the spelling, grammatical and punctuation aspects of writing. We will continue to practice handwriting that involves correct letter formation for lower case letters and capital letters.	<b>Science</b> - During this term we will be learning about plants. In the second half of the term our topic will be investigating materials. We will also be continuing to look at the seasons.
<b>Computing</b> - We will be focussing on coding, using spreadsheets and technology outside of school.		<b>Music</b> - Children will be exploring the idea of beat, as well as listening to classical music. They will also look at mood, tempo, dynamics and rhythm through our Sing Up music scheme.
<b>RE</b> – The children will be learning about humanism and comparing this view of personal belief to organised religions.	Maths - The children will revisit, develop and secure their understanding of number and number bonds through daily Number Sense sessions. In lessons will focus further on the following units: Year 1 – Numbers to 20, addition and subtraction within 10., money, shape, position/direction and time. Year 2 – Addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers, introduction to multiplication, introduction to division structures and shape. Children are encouraged to use the Numbots to support fluency.	
		<b>P.E.</b> - During the first half of term we will be learning about striking and fielding activities. During the second half term we will be learning about multi- skills and athletics.
<b>Humanities</b> – In history we are looking at how the seaside holiday began. In geography, during the second part of the term, we are discovering how does our weather changes?		
<b>Jigsaw</b> – Relationships is our topic this half term, which looks closely at friendships. After half term the topic is 'changing me'.	<b>At home</b> - Please help your child develop their reading by reading with them daily. This could be your child reading to you or you reading to them.
